ASSESSMENT TEST

On the first session the pupil will sit an assessment test. Based on the results of the assessment, a pupil's individual education plan will be developed that will focus on key areas. The 2-hour-session can be dedicated for one subject (e.g. Maths) or can be split between two subjects (e.g. Maths & English).

The fees range from £10 - £15 per hour
